

Minutes of the Regular
Scheduled Meeting
Troup City Council
December 17, 2013

A Re-Scheduled Meeting of the Troup City Council was held Tuesday December 17, 2013 at 5:30 p.m. in the T.I.S.D. Administration Building located at 201 N. Carolina, Troup, Texas. Councilpersons present were: Mayor John Whitsell, Jeff Hale, Joe Carlyle, Gary Salyer, Chip Richardson and Mayor Pro Tem Carole Wilson. Also present were City Administrator Gene Cottle and City Secretary Buffie Deason.

Mayor John Whitsell called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m. noting all Council Persons were present.

Mayor Whitsell – Led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Whitsell – Item 3 Discuss and consider approving the minutes of the November 12, 2013 Troup City Council Meeting. Council person Chip Richardson made the motion to approve the minutes. Councilperson Jeff Hale seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

He advised Council that the water discoloration is starting when we treat the water, and that John Phillips is still trying to get the problem resolved. He introduced new police officer Audry Teter.
