

Minutes of the Regular
Scheduled Meeting
Troup City Council
July 19, 2016

A Scheduled Meeting of the Troup City Council was held Tuesday July 19, 2016 at 6:41 pm at the Cameron J-Jarvis Troup Municipal Library located at 102 S. Georgia, Troup, Texas. Councilpersons present were: Mayor Joe Carlyle, Gary Salyer, Chip Richardson, and Carole Wilson. Also present were City Manager Gene Cottle and City Secretary Buffie Deason.

Mayor Joe Carlyle called the meeting to order at 6:41 p.m. noting all Council members were present with the exception of Jeff Hale and Nelson Darden. Guest included Suzanne Loudamy, Layne and Karon Bonnet, Pat Hendrix, and Jason Campbell.

Gary Salyer led the invocation.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 4 Consider approval of the minutes from the Regular Scheduled Meeting of June 21, 2016. Councilperson Chip Richardson made the motion to approve the minutes as written. Councilperson Gary Salyer seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 5 Citizen Comments- Brief Comments concerning non-Agenda items. No comments made.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 6 Review and consider the city financial report for the month of June 2016. City Manager Gene Cottle presented Council with a financial report. Councilperson Chip Richardson made the motion to approve the financials for the month of June. Councilperson Gary Salyer seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 7 Comments, questions or input from City Manager's written report. City Manager Gene Cottle presented Council with his monthly report and the police report.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 8 Agenda request from Evelyn Curl requesting to reopen N. Railroad Street at the Tarbutton Street intersection. Mayor Carlyle said that this street is graveled and in better shape than most streets. No action taken.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 9 Discuss and consider a preliminary re-plat of property located on the E. Gee Survey A-10 (located on the corner of Hutto and Short Street) for Campbell Homes. Jason Cambell addressed Council about his re-plat and his plans to build 4 houses on the property. Councilperson Gary Salyer made the motion to approve the preliminary re-plat with the noted corrections. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 10 Discuss and consider approving the Smith County 911 budget for 2016-2017 fiscal year. Councilperson Chip Richardson made the motion to approve the Smith County 911 budget for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. Councilperson Carole Wilson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 11 Discuss and consider allowing a budget adjustment for the Cameron J-Jarvis library to use unused grant funds in the amount of \$1905.00 from 2010-2011 fiscal year. City Manager Gene Cottle said that the library received the grant and they did not use all the funds. Mr. Cottle said that we would need to do a budget amendment. Councilperson Carole Wilson made the motion to make a budget adjustment for the Cameron J-Jarvis library to use unused grants funds in the amount of \$1905.00 from the 2010-2011 fiscal year with amendments being made to 04-408-169 from \$0.00 to \$1905.00 and 04-508-154 from \$3000.00 to \$4905.00. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 12 Discuss agenda request by Layne and Karon Bonnet about the de-annexation of the property located at 22498 CR 2144 legal description Tract 89 of ABST A1099 W George. Layne and Karon Bonnet

addressed Council about the City providing this property with City water with the plans to make it a RV park. The City engineer provided the City with four different cost routes. City Administrator told Council that the developer would have to pay for the water lines to be installed. The Council did not take action on this item due to the Bonnet's not have a definitive use for the property.


Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 13 Discuss and consider Library Board Recommendations for appointment of Board Member positions for even years with terms expiring in 2018 for appointees Navoleine Roddy, Angela Foster, Sonja Rountree, and Joe McElroy, and terms of service for the Cameron-J. Jarvis Troup Municipal Library. Ms. Carole Wilson said that all appointees agreed to serve. Councilperson Carole Wilson made the motion to appoint as Board members positions for even years with terms expiring in 2018 for appointees Navoleine Roddy, Angela Foster, Sonja Rountree, and Joe McElroy, and terms of service for the Cameron-J. Jarvis Troup Municipal Library. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Joe Carlyle Item 14 Preliminary discussion on 2016-2017 Budget and presentation of proposed Budget Calendar. City Manager presented Council with a preliminary budget for review. No action taken.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 15 Comments and input from Council, Mayor or City Manager concerning items of interest or items for a future agenda. Councilperson Gary Salyer ask what we did with our stray dogs. Mr. Cottle said that at the time we have no shelter to take them.

Mayor Joe Carlyle – Item 16 Adjourn at 8:17 p.m.
