

Minutes of the Regular
Scheduled Meeting
Troup City Council
November 19, 2018

A Scheduled Meeting and Public Hearing of the Troup City Council was held Monday November 19, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the Cameron J-Jarvis Troup Municipal Library located at 102 S. Georgia, Troup, Texas. Councilpersons were: Mayor Joe Carlyle, Jeff Hale, Nelson Darden, Brandi Barton, Chip Richardson, and Carole Wilson. Also present was City Secretary Buffie Deason.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. noting all Council members were present with the exception of Joe Carlyle and Nelson Darden.

Jeff Hale led the invocation.

Jeff Hale led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 4 Consider approval of the minutes from the Regular Scheduled Meeting October 15, 2018. This item was tabled.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 5 Citizen Comments- Brief Comments concerning non-Agenda items. No comments were made.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 6 Review and consider the city financial report for the month of October 2018. Councilperson Chip Richardson made the motion to accept the financial report. Councilperson Jeff Hale seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 7 Comments, questions or input from City Manager’s written report. Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson presented Council with monthly report.

Nelson Darden joined the meeting at 6:37 p.m.



Councilperson Jeff Hale made the motion to approve the Final Plat of the Redding Subdivision located on West Oak Street. Councilperson Brandi Barton seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 11 Discuss and consider approving the preliminary plat for The Fox Run Addition of the Eason Gee Survey A-10 located in the ETJ of the City of Troup. City Secretary Buffie Deason presented Council with the preliminary plat. She told Council that the City Inspector had reviewed the plat and that an easement would have to be added to keep the property behind it from becoming land locked. Councilperson Jeff Hale made the motion to approve the preliminary plat for The Fox Run Addition of the Eason Gee Survey A-10 located in the ETJ of the City of Troup with the understanding the final plat would need to have an easement on it. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
