

Minutes of the Regular
Scheduled Meeting
Troup City Council
December 16, 2019

A Scheduled Meeting and Public Hearing of the Troup City Council was held Tuesday December 16, 2019 at 6:30 pm at the Cameron J-Jarvis Troup Municipal Library located at 102 S. Georgia, Troup, Texas.
